

SOUNDSIDE DRIVE SEPTIC TO SEWER PROJECT

PROJECT UPDATE

Utility Services Company of Gulf Breeze has been awarded the construction contract, and work on the project has begun.

On February 19, 2023, the project team comprising representatives from Santa Rosa County, the City of Gulf Breeze, Baskerville-Donovan Engineering, Utility Services Company, and Pump and Process convened a stakeholders meeting at the Tiger Point Community Center. During the session, the project team delivered an overview presentation to stakeholders, followed by a question and answer segment. The meeting was live-streamed on the project's Facebook page. Utility Services Company outlined the planned construction direction, moving from West to East on Soundside Drive and from East to West on Spruce Street west of Woodlawn Beach Road. Pump and Process showcased an actual grinder pump for stakeholders to inspect.

Utility Services will be operating within the Right-of-way for the upcoming weeks, after which they will commence work on private property. Representatives from Utility Services will be present in the project area and will reach out to stakeholders individually to discuss the construction methods and procedures specific to each parcel.
